During their stay in St. Vincent the invited visitors and investors will be taken to the various tourism sites on the island, including diving and snorkelling sites, which are rated as some of the best in the world.

This week marks the completion of Phase 1A of the resort, with 68 villas, two restaurants, reception building, pool facilities, Little Harlequin Kids' Club and the beach which has been transformed from black to pure white sand.

The other villas will be fine tuned and released in phases with the Liverpool Football Academy and Pat Cash Tennis Academy to open at the end of the month.

Currently 210 workers are employed at Buccament Bay Resort with the number to increase to 600 in February 2011 when Phase 1 is fully completed.
